What we've been learning recently

English – We have written our instructions on how to make a marmalade sandwich. We have used bossy verbs and time conjunctions to make sure we wrote them in order. Then, we followed the instructions to make our own marmalade sandwiches to enjoy for snack time.

Maths – We have been learning about shapes. We have been naming, sorting and recognising 2D and 3D shapes. We know how to explain the difference between a square and a rectangle. We also know how to decide if 3D shapes will roll or stack depending on if they have a curved edge. During COOL time we have enjoyed making 3D shape towers!

Wider Curriculum – In Geography, we have been learning about the UK. We know the 4 names of the countries that make up the UK and learnt what the 4 capital cities are called. Then we carried out some field work around the school by using a map to find signs of the changing seasons. We have also learnt how to use a compass and a funny saying to remember the compass points (naughty elephants squirt water).

- Carrying out more fieldwork around the school in Geography
