What we've been learning recently

English — We have started learning the story of 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch' by Ronda and David Armitage. We have really focused on developing our VIPERS skills when reading. Together we looked at some of the trickier vocabulary within the text and made our own mini thesaurus'. We also made predictions about how the Grinling's would save the basket of food from the seagulls.

Maths – We are now learning about position and direction. We have been using a range of words to describe position, such as; left, right, above, below, forwards and backwards. We learnt a trick with our hands to show us which way is Left and which way is Right – ask us to show you!

Wider Curriculum – We have been learning all about our body and the different parts. We have really focused on the 5 senses and how they work. We have also been making some suncatchers to enter to the Royal Cornwall Show. We had great fun creating colours and sparkles to shine in the sunshine.
