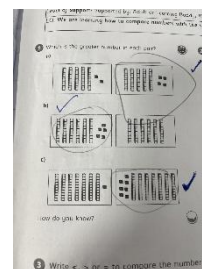

What we've been learning recently

English – We have been writing our own versions of the Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch. We have been including adjectives and suffixes in our writing. We then came up with our own alternate ending to trick the seagulls. Ask us about our new ending; it will make you laugh!

Maths – We continued learning about place value to 100. We have been partitioning numbers using part-whole models using our 10s and 1s. Then we moved onto comparing numbers to 100 using $<$ $>$ $=$. We looked how many 10s and 1s they had, noticing more 10s means a greater number.

Wider Curriculum – We have been Geographers! We have used atlases to find and name the 7 continents. We labelled a world map and found which continent we live in. Then we looked at human and physical features of our local area. We were team work turtles to make maps of Wadebridge including these features. Next we are going to be looking at human and physical features of Shanghai!
