What we've been learning recently

English – The children have concluded their playscript learning journey this week. We used our potions made on World Book Day as the basis of our extension chapter onto George's Marvellous Medicine. After writing our playscripts, we then enjoyed performing to the class!

Maths – We have also completed our mass and capacity learning journey. The children learnt how to measure in kg and g, they used scales which will come in handy for cooking in the summer term. We also understood equivalent capacities, adding and subtracting capacities and comparing mass, capacity and volume.

Wider Curriculum – In history, we discovered why the Romans invaded Britain, how they were so successful and what the Romans brought to the country. We put their success into action by creating our own battle formations on the field. In Science, we have been continuing to learn about light and shadows and why they change throughout the day.
