What we've been learning recently

English – We started our new learning journey of stories with familiar settings. Our focus text is 'The Sand Horse' which is a story based in St Ives that the children have been reading and basing their learning of English techniques such as use prepositions and developing setting description.

Maths – We have completed our final fraction learning journey. The children used their knowledge of division to work out fractions of whole numbers. We have also added and subtracted fractions and reasoned with fractions with an amount.

Wider Curriculum – In R.E, we enjoyed visiting Egloshayle Church. One of the highlights of the visit was sharing bread together as they learned about the Last Supper and its meaning. The children were full of thoughtful questions and showed great curiosity and respect throughout the visit. In D.T, we have begun learning about why eating seasonal fruit and veg is important. We are learning about seasonal fruit which we can use in a tart and will be planning our recipes this week. In Science, we are learning about functions of different flowering plants.

Over the next fortnight we will be...

- In English, we will be adapting the story of the Sand Horse to our own sand animals.
- In Maths, we will be learning all about money and how to find change.
- In DT, we will be making and cooking a seasonal tart.
- In Science, we will be continuing to understand what plants and animals need to survive and their adaptations.
- Continuing with track athletics and rounders in P.E.
- Practicing our Roman Assembly for Thursday 8th May!
