What we've been learning recently

English – This week we have finished our innovated 'Sand Horse' stories which we shared with the Year 2s. We have then started our new unit of Poetry. We will explore poems, identify the structure and rhyming within a poem and finish by writing our own poem about where we live.

Maths – This week we completed our money learning journey and have begun learning about time! Next, we will understand Roman numerals, tell the time to one minute, read digital clocks, use a given duration to find start and end times before solving problems with time.

Wider Curriculum – In D.T, we applied our learning of seasonal fruit to make a seasonal tart. The children learnt about different cutting techniques, hygiene, kitchen safety, and assembling a tart together. In our school kitchen we then prepped the food before adding it to our puff pastry. We were very pleased with our yummy tarts! In Science, we have been busy carrying out experiments on what plants need to survive. In PSHE, we have been learning about relationships and how to deal with conflict.

Over the next fortnight we will be...

- In English, we will be developing our poetry skills and writing our own poems.
- In Maths, we will be learning about time.
- In DT, we will be using clay to sculpture birds and paint them. We are also starting work on our sculpture for the RCS - a large model lion!
- In Science, we are continuing to investigate the effects of water on plants and how plants reproduce.
- In PE, we will be continuing with track athletics and rounders.
