

# Year 3 News 20<sup>th</sup> June 2025











#### What we've been learning recently

English – This week we have written our own newspapers based around sewage in our Cornish waters. The children have incorporated key features of newspaper articles, such as headlines, bylines, introductions, the 5Ws (who, what, where, when, why), direct and reported speech, and captions in their work.

Maths – We have finished our learning journey of time and are now moving onto shape. We will learn about angles, parallel lines, and be able to recognise a variety of 2D and 3D shapes.

Wider Curriculum – In art, we have created our own tree scenes inspired by Eloise Renouf. In P.E., the children have loved refining their skills in archery and doing sports day practice before we move on to tennis. In geography, we are learning about Antarctica as well as clarifying key terms such as glaciers and icebergs. In R.E. we have continued to look into different Cornish festivals, why they occur, and we enjoyed singing some Cornish songs! In computing, we are learning that computers don't just work by magic and that they have different components like the CPU, hard drive and GPU. We also began to learn about algorithms and tried to make Mr Langton make a sandwich using specific instructions which got a bit messy!

#### Over the next fortnight we will be...

- In English, we are moving onto our final Fiction unit. It is a story from another culture and is called 'How Maui Tamed the Sun'.
- In maths, we will identify right angles, measure and draw accurately and recognise horizontal and vertical lines.
- In R.E., we will continue looking at Cornish festivals and Cornish heritage.
- In our wider curriculum we are going to continue to learn about cream applied.
  Antarctica; continue our athletics and archery, and sketch and print trees in art.
