# What we've been learning recently

English – In English, the learning journey based on stories from diverse cultures has come to an end. The children have enjoyed using 'the more, the more' sentence types, 'descriptive detail sentence types, written setting descriptions, and '3 ed' sentences in their work. They have edited their work and shared with their peers which has been lovely to see.

Maths – We have finished the learning journey on statistics. A highlight of the journey was drawing bar charts and the children enjoyed visiting different classes as part of their data collection.

Wider Curriculum – In PE, the children have loved refining their skills in archery and practicing in tennis. In geography, we have finished our unit around Antarctica and enjoyed learning about the expedition of Shackleton. In DT, we have planned our final cushion design and practiced different stitches like cross stitching and layering. In PSHE, we have been learning about changes we will experience as we get older. We also went on an exciting school trip to Trevean, where children learnt to make fires, identify mini beats, and learn how to use a compass.
