What we've been learning recently

English – This week in English, Year 4 have planned and written their own “Conquering the Monster” story based in a Viking village. They have blown us away with their descriptive writing and worked so hard to improve their accuracy. Maths – Year 4 have focused on division this week. They have been “Keep Going Koalas” when learning some tricky new ideas such as remainders and have focused on using manipulatives to help them group equally. Well done!

Wider Curriculum – In History, we have been looking at how the Anglo Saxons ruled Britain and what beliefs they held. We compared Christianity with Paganism and explored how the Anglo Saxons converted to Christianity over a long period of time. In Art, the children have started creating their sculptures of Vikings based on the work of Edgar Degas.
