What we've been learning recently

English – Check out these incredible non-chronological reports (pictured above) all about bees. All of the children have worked hard to include lots of technical vocabulary to help them sound like Bee Experts! Through writing their reports, they have also learnt about the present perfect tense, third person, conjunctions and formality.

Maths – Year 4 have completed a unit of work on fractions, gaining confidence in converting and calculating with mixed numbers and improper fractions.

Wider Curriculum – In Art, we have been looking at the work of Paul Cezanne and have learnt about what is meant by a "Still Life". The children then arranged fruit in a bowl to create their own Cezanne-inspired compositions. In Geography, the children have been investigating where our food comes from. They have debated the pros and cons of local/imported food and have looked at food packaging to calculate the food miles of various food products.

- Discovering how sound waves travel in Science.
