What we've been learning recently

An incredibly "buzzy" end of term! Year 4 blew our socks off with their energy and commitment to the play. A huge WELL DONE!

English – The children have explored poetry in the run up to Easter and have learnt all about limericks and clerihews. They had lots of fun experimenting with rhyme to create some silly and brilliant poems!

Maths – Year 4 have finished their work on fractions and demonstrated impressive understanding of the topic in their end of unit test.

Wider Curriculum – In our final Geography lesson of the term, children enjoyed focusing on their oracy skills for No Pen Day. After briefly recapping our learning over the unit and sharing some top tips for speaking and listening in groups, the children engaged in impressive group discussions around the question, "Should we stop importing food?" Just some of their thoughtful responses were "Yes – because stopping climate change is much more important than our favourite foods!" (Annie) to "No - but we should make sure that all the vehicles used are electric" (Stanley).
