



Year 4 News 6th June 2025









What we've been learning recently

English — Year 4 have been learning about conjunctions of time and causal conjunctions. They will use these in their final write-up of their explanation texts linked to their science learning all about the digestive system. They have remembered this topic so well from last term and are beginning to write like real experts — well done year 4!

Maths – In Maths, Year 4 have begun learning about money. They can now convert between pounds and pence e.g. £4.78 = 478p, building on all of their previous learning around decimal place value.

Wider Curriculum – Year 4 have begun a new geography learning journey all about rivers. So far they have learnt about the water cycle – see if they can explain it to you using the vocabulary **condensation** and **evaporation**. They have also been practicing their sewing skills ready for producing their final textiles artwork. Over the next fortnight we will be...

- This term in maths, the focus will be on applying their number skills into real-life situations. Shape, coordinates, time and statistics are just some of the exciting maths learning topics coming up.
