




Year 4 News 4th July 2025





What we've been learning recently

English – Year 4 have continued their work on The Firework Maker's Daughter by Philip Pullman. They have enjoyed reading about Lila's perilous journey to become a Firework Maker and have used this as inspiration to write their own 'missing chapter' of the book. We have been so impressed with the descriptive vocabulary that the children have used in this piece of extended writing that the children have published their chapters into their Star Writers books.

Maths – In Maths, Year 4 have been learning about 2D shapes. They have been naming polygons and identifying their features as well as learning about angles and finally exploring lines of symmetry.

Wider Curriculum – Over the last couple of weeks, Year 4 have been doing lots of PSHE as they progress through the 'Changing Me' unit of work. We have been bowled over by their considered questions and mature attitudes to these conversations. They have also begun a new unit of work for Design Technology. Children have explored different types of structures using toothpicks and marshmallows. They have now designed their own pavilions and are looking forward to making them next week

Over the next fortnight we will be...

- We will continue our work on shape, coordinates, and statistics as well as revisiting Time as many of our children found this challenging.
- Our English lessons will be using their knowledge and understanding of 'The Firework Maker's Daughter' to write their own poetry next week.
- Learning about conservation in Science. Year 4 will learn about deforestation, water pollution and air pollution. This will culminate in the children creating a design for their own conservation area – choosing what wildlife they will prioritize and explaining what steps they will take to protect it.
