#### What we've been learning recently

English – We've started using our V.I.P.E.R.S. skills to analyse *The Shark Caller*. We've worked on improving our vocabulary, making inferences, and predicting what might happen next. We've also practiced finding key details and explaining how they relate to the main themes. These skills have helped us understand the story better and dive deeper into *The Shark Caller*.

Maths – Over the past two weeks, we've been learning how to use decimals, fractions, and percentages in maths. We've seen how decimals and fractions show parts of a whole, helping us measure things like distance and time. Percentages help us understand proportions, showing how many parts out of 100.

Wider Curriculum – In the last two weeks, we've learned why oceans are so important. Oceans help control the climate, provide oxygen, and support animals and plants. They also give us food, resources, and ways to travel. By studying the oceans, we've learned how important it is to take care of them for the future of our planet.
