What we've been learning recently

English – Over the next few weeks, we will be completing an RE unit as part of our English lessons. With SATs, our recent focus has been on writing and test preparation. Now, we're taking the opportunity to explore our RE question in more depth: *"For Christians, what kind of king is Jesus?"* This thought-provoking unit will take us through to the end of half term.

Maths – We have now completed all of our White Rose Maths units. Over the coming weeks, we will use this time to revisit key concepts, address any misconceptions, and consolidate learning. The children will also enjoy some exciting investigative maths activities planned by Mrs. Callister.

Wider Curriculum – In our wider curriculum, we've taken on the role of historians as we begin learning all about the Ancient Greeks. The children have started their journey by exploring key events from Greek times and placing them in chronological order on a timeline.
