What we've been learning recently

Play – Our focus over the past two weeks has been preparing for our Year 6 play, *The Next Big Step*. The children have been working incredibly hard—rehearsing scenes, learning lines and songs, and bringing their characters to life. We've also started gathering costumes and props to help set the scene. On stage, we're now fine-tuning the details, focusing on how the children move, project their voices, and bring energy to each performance. Rehearsals will continue into next week, and we can't wait for you to see all their hard work come together.

Transition – This week, many of our Year 6 pupils took part in their three-day transition at the secondary school. Over the course of the visit, they spent time with their new form groups, getting a real sense of what life will be like in September.
