## Top 5 facts

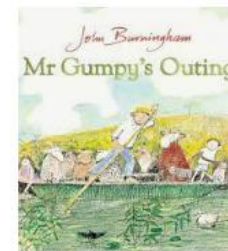
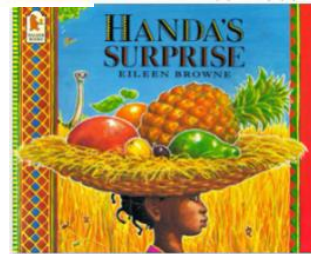
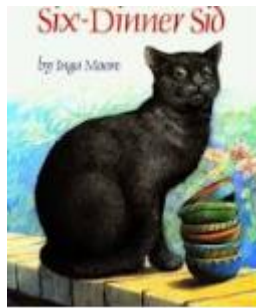
Africa is a continent that has lots of countries within it.
