- Writing captions and sentences.

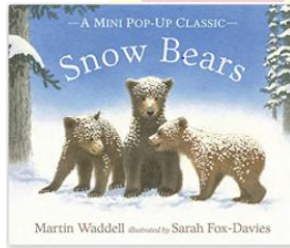
