What we've been learning recently

English – What a wonderful few weeks it's been learning different fairytales. This week, we have been learning 'The Enormous Turnip' and the children have enjoyed learning all about root vegetables. They have been very busy retelling the story and have made their own version called 'The Gigantic Carrot'.

Maths – We continue to focus on number bonds to 10, so please do ask your child to recall these at home. This week, we have focused on doubling numbers to 10. The children have completed a range of activities including finding doubles in slime, matching dominoes and using playdoh to make doubles.

Wider Curriculum – As part of our RE lessons looking at signs of new life, the children went on a Spring walk around the school grounds. They enjoyed using their clipboard and ticking off the signs of Spring that they could see. We touched on the Easter story, which we will be learning more about leading up to Easter.
