Top 5 facts

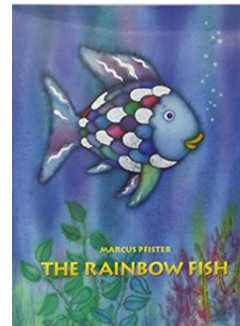
There are 5 different oceans.
