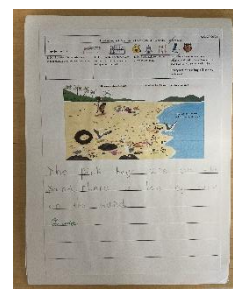
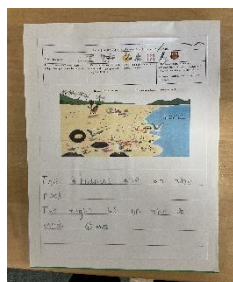

What we've been learning recently

English – We have almost come to the end of our Level 4 Phonics learning. We will spend until the end of term consolidating learning, particularly of the level 4 Tricky words and tricky blends of sounds. We are so proud of how well the children have progressed in Phonics throughout the year. Well done Reception for your hard work and determination.

Maths – Over the last two weeks, the children have been learning about sharing equally, along with odd and even numbers. This has allowed for some very practical lessons involving some enticing resources such as biscuits! When learning about sharing equally, we find that the children soon understand this concept, particularly when we involve food! It's been great watching the children develop the understanding and deeper thinking of this concept.

Wider Curriculum – Next week, we will be looking at modes of transport, including water transport. This will give the children the opportunity to design and create their own vehicles. If you have any junk modelling materials at home that you no longer need, please do bring them in for us. We can't wait to see what they create!
