




# Year 1 News

### What we've been learning recently

**English** – We are using Jack and the Beanstalk for our learning currently and have been writing sentences, making sure to include a capital letter, full stop and with finger spaces. We have written about the characters, the setting and used adjectives to describe the hen and harp that Jack stole. We have also learnt about -er, -est and -ing suffixes, using them in our writing.

**Maths** – We are learning place value of numbers 20 – 50 in Maths and the children have enjoyed working with bigger numbers. We looked at how many tens and ones are in a number, used part whole models to partition different numbers to 50 and have been making numbers using the correct amount of tens and ones.

**Wider Curriculum** – In Science, we have been investigating 'how do the seasons change?' and taking a closer look at each season in turn – what the weather might be like, what clothes we might wear, what activities we do and what the trees might look like. We loved celebrating World Book Day and St Piran's Day – the children look fabulous! We spent time reading and discussing our favourite books and we had a visit from the Year 5 children who read stories to the children.

### Over the next fortnight we will be...

- In English, we will be rewriting parts of the story, Jack and the Beanstalk before inventing a new ending.
- Using clay to explore what different effects we can create in Art.
- In Maths, we will be continuing our learning in place value.
