What we've been learning recently

English — We have started our new learning journey of narrative writing. We have been learning the story of 'Slowly, Slowly, Slowly said the Sloth'. We have been thinking of adjectives to describe the animals from the story, then creating expanded noun phrase sentences. Then we thought of way the animals move to write sentences with verbs and adverbs.

Maths – We have begun our place value learning journey. We have been exploring numbers to 100 by using part-whole models to partition as well as place value charts to show 10s and 1s. We have practiced reading and writing numbers to 100.

Wider Curriculum – In geography we have been answering the question 'Why is our world wonderful?' We have been using atlases and Google Earth on the iPads to explore famous landmarks in the UK and around the world. We learnt the names of the 7 continents and located the 5 oceans.

Over the next fortnight we will be...

- Continuing to move our bodies in dance.
- Starting to learn about habitats in science.
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s in maths.
- Continuing exploring how Christians believe God created the world in RE.
- Innovating the story of 'Slowly, Slowly, Slowly said the Sloth' using different characters, adjectives and adverbs.
