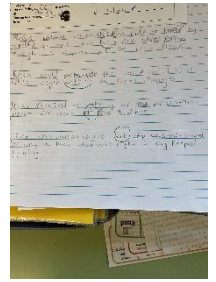

What we've been learning recently

English – We have been writing all about Rosa Parks using four sentence types (exclamation, question, command and statement) e.g. how did she feel when she had to move seats?, and Stop segregation! Then we looked at the features of a biography and worked in pairs to identify the features. This is in preparation for writing our own.

Maths – We have been exploring volume and capacity and understanding the difference. We have been learning how to use this vocabulary to describe containers of liquid and realising containers can appear to hold the same amount of liquid but their capacity could be different. Measuring in ml/l would be the way to find out.

Wider Curriculum – In Art, we have created portraits inspired by Frida Kahlo. We have sketched our faces and drawn backgrounds that represent us. Then we have used watercolours to mix skin tones to paint our face. We have also created pop art style portraits in the style of Andy Warhol.
