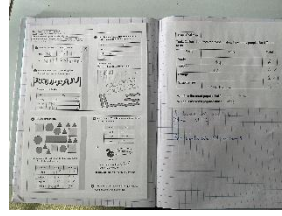




# Year 2 News

### What we've been learning recently

**English** – English time has been spent rehearsing for our Year 2 assembly (speaking and listening) last week but this week we have returned to our learning based upon the story, The Sand Horse. The children have experimented with speech punctuation and have made a start innovating the story to create their very own versions.

**Maths** – Although we have completed our unit on time, we are constantly referring to the analogue clock throughout the day to help embed our learning. We have begun to look at statistics, specifically different representations of data from tally charts to block diagrams and interpretation of these.

**Wider Curriculum** – The last couple of weeks has seen a return to Geography learning in our wider curriculum lessons. We are exploring "What is it like to live by the coast?" which follows on nicely from our local history studies. In PE, we have been doing athletics; learning and practising techniques of jumping and throwing. In RE, we have continued exploring different religious places, focusing on synagogues and mosques.

### Over the next fortnight we will be...

- Continuing our work on statistics; using data and drawing our own diagrams and tables.
- In English, we will write our versions of The Sand Horse and share with our Year 3 buddies.
- Next week, we will see more preparation for our Royal Cornwall Show entries in art (sculpture).
