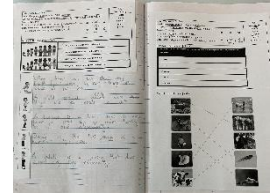




Year 2 News

What we've been learning recently

English – The children were very proud to complete their versions of The Sand Horse which have been their absolute best writing to date. They are applying Year 2 writing skills with confidence and accuracy and had a great time sharing with their Year 3 buddies. The feedback was excellent and the children enjoyed seeing what writing in Year 3 looks like as well. In reading, the children have been showing off their comprehension skills; making sure they read the text carefully and find evidence to support their answers.

Maths – We have been learning about statistics; different ways of representing data, interpreting data and creating our own data representations. We have looked at tally charts, block diagrams and pictograms. We have also been showing off our arithmetic and reasoning skills.

Wider Curriculum – The children have begun learning about life-cycles in Science. This links very well with our PSHE learning, where we have begun to explore changes that happen in our lives. In PE, we have started to learn how to play rounders as well as continuing to develop our athletics skills in preparation for our Sports Day (see Important Notices).

Over the next fortnight we will be...

- Making a start on learning about position and direction in Maths. We will be thinking a lot about the language used to describe positions and turns building on our knowledge of fractions
- In English, we will begin a non-fiction unit of writing based upon the life and work of Charles Darwin.
- We will continue our work on life-cycles in Science and begin to look at what makes some people and places in Cornwall sacred.
