

What we've been learning recently

English – This week, we began planning and writing non-chronological reports about Cornish pasties. We began the week researching key information to use as subheadings such as the history, nutrition, ingredients, and where to buy them. The children are then going to use their research to construct non-chronological reports about the Cornish pasty!

Maths – In Maths, we have continued our focus on Multiplication and Division. We have been working hard to multiply and divide 3 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers, and have progressed our focus to investigate divisions with remainders. We will soon be finishing this cycle with a revision lesson and a test to show our knowledge. We have continued to practice our timetables with our weekly carousels, and we will be testing our multiplication skills with an MTC mock.

Wider Curriculum – As part of our Science topic, we have been investigating how vibrations are created and how sound waves travel through different mediums. In Art, we are focusing on the artist Paul Cezanne, by arranging and sketching still life objects, just like his artwork. In Geography last week, we studied food miles, where different sources of food come from and the effect it can have on the environment. We then discussed products that we consume and the food miles it took in order to reach us.
