What we've been learning recently

English – The children have continued investigating instructions on the topic 'How to slay the Minotaur'. We have been building different parts of the text by focusing on expanded noun phrases, coordinating conjunctions and commands. They have made a great start so far! The children also completed their PIRA assessments at the end of last week, assessing their reading comprehension.

Maths – We have continued with decimals, focusing on dividing 1-digit and 2-digit numbers by 10 and converting them into decimal numbers where needed. We will then move on to hundredths as fractions and decimals. The children have also completed their PUMA assessments, well done!

Wider Curriculum – We took part in DT week with our 'Together at the Table' event, where we made different dishes from countries around the world. 4W made curries inspired by India, and 4B made pizzas inspired by Italy. Thank you to all the parents who came to visit the classes and try the dishes. In RE, our enquiry question is 'What kind of world did Jesus want?' We researched Christian role models who have done something good to make the world a better place. In Geography, we have continued learning about rivers, looking at the different uses of a river, and problems that can occur such as flooding, pollution and drought.
