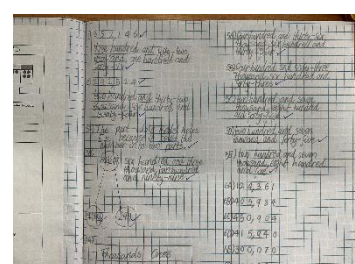
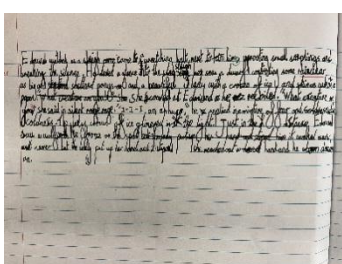
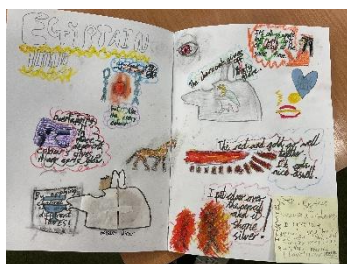

What we've been learning recently

English – We have started our new learning journey of Old Literature. Our focus text is 'The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe' by C.S Lewis. The children have been focusing on the opening and build up of the story, using comparative language, prepositional phrases and relative clauses – if you're unsure what these are, ask them!

Maths – We have begun our Place Value journey. The children have looked at numbers up to 1,000,000 and exploring different ways of partitioning larger numbers. This week we have been learning to compare and order numbers to 1,000,000, and round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.

Wider Curriculum – In art, we have been exploring the work of Hossam Dirar – an Egyptian artist whose contemporary art gives a nod to ancient Egyptian hieroglyphic symbols. Children used their sketchbooks to use a range of different media to create texture and tone.

Over the next fortnight we will be...

- Writing our own versions of the opening of The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe.
- Learning about adding and subtracting numbers with more than 4 digits in maths.
- Starting our history learning and looking at what the ancient Egyptians believed.
- Continuing our RSE healthy relationships and setting personal boundaries.
