




# Year 6 News

### What we've been learning recently

**English** – In English, we have been busy finishing, editing, and improving our diary entries, focusing on adding detail and emotion to our writing. We have now started an exciting new poetry unit exploring figurative language, inspired by the powerful text *Rose Blanche*. The children have also been immersed in a range of engaging texts during our reading sessions and particularly enjoyed getting to grips with Lewis Carroll's *Jabberwocky* last week — there was lots of laughter as we tackled those wonderfully tricky nonsense words!

**Maths** – We are continuing our unit on multiplication and division, where the children have been thrown straight into long division. They have coped brilliantly with this new challenge — their accuracy and confidence are improving no end, and this progress is already being reflected in their weekly arithmetic results.

**Wider Curriculum** – Across the wider curriculum, many of the children have completed their Bikeability training, earning praise from the instructor for their excellent effort and attitude.
