

What we've been learning recently

English – In English, we have started exploring our new stimulus text, *Holes* — always a firm favourite among teachers! The children have engaged in thoughtful discussions about the story and answered a range of targeted questions. They have also described the setting of the infamous Camp Green Lake and begun crafting their own narratives, carefully integrating descriptive detail to bring their writing to life.

Maths – In maths, we have been recapping all things fractions — with plenty of talk about cakes, pizzas, and chocolate bars (often leaving us all a little hungry)! The children have shown great recall of their Year 5 knowledge and have confidently applied it to tackle a range of challenging reasoning questions.

Wider Curriculum – Within our wider curriculum, we have begun our exciting electricity unit in science — which has certainly sparked some interesting and insightful discussions! The children loved their first hockey lesson with DT sports coaches, where they were learning to control and pass the ball.

Over the next fortnight we will be...

English: We will continue exploring **non-chronological reports**, focusing on identifying key features, planning effectively, and creating our own reports.

Maths: We will continue our **fractions journey**, beginning with a focus on **multiplying and dividing fractions**.
