What we've been learning recently

English – In English over the last two weeks, the children have been finishing off our *Alma* unit, carefully polishing their final pieces of writing. Maths – Over the last two weeks in Maths, we have finished the statistics unit, where they worked hard to interpret and present data using a range of graphs and charts.
