What we've been learning recently

Maths: In Maths, we have been revising key arithmetic skills, including addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, to build confidence and fluency. We have also been practising Year 7 topics, solving a range of reasoning and problem-solving questions to strengthen our understanding and ensure we are well prepared for the challenges ahead.

English: In English, we have written the first draft of our explanation text about the circulatory system. We have focused on explaining how the circulatory system works using clear, organised writing, accurate scientific vocabulary and a formal tone. We have also been using paragraphs, conjunctions and diagrams to present information clearly, ready to edit and improve our work in the next lesson.

Wider curriculum: In PSHE, we have begun our new Jigsaw unit, **Changing Me**, where children are learning about growing up and the physical and emotional changes that happen as they get older. We have explored the importance of positive self-esteem, respecting ourselves and others, and understanding that everyone develops at their own pace. Throughout the unit, children will have opportunities to ask questions in a safe, supportive environment as they learn about puberty, healthy relationships, and preparing for the transition to the next school year – if you have any questions about these lessons do not hesitate to contact us.
